PARKING TICKETS:

This is taking place in Houston right now but it could be enforced in League City also. Just wanted to make you aware of these parking violations that could be fined in our neighborhoods also.

"In an effort to generate increased revenue, the City of Houston Parking Management Division will be performing sweeps of Clear Lake area neighborhoods during January and February. Please be aware that they will be ticketing a variety of parking violations including the following: blocking the sidewalk (including the sidewalk that crosses your driveway), parking on the wrong side of the street (against traffic), parking too close to a crosswalk (20 feet), stop sign (30 feet) or fire hydrant (15 feet), and parking too far (over 18") from the curb (head-in parking in cul-de-sacs is not allowed)." To avoid costly fines, please abide by all parking rules especially the examples above.

CENTERPOINTE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION (CPOA):

Our CPOA Annual Meeting will be held at the YMCA on March 24th. Sign in will begin at 6:30pm and the meeting will be called to order at 7:00 PM. If you are interested in running for a board position please send your bio in so that it can be included in next month's Newsletter. There will also be a chance for you to submit your name at the annual meeting. So far we have 2 residents who have decided to run for the board. They are Liz Dominick and Jody Heeb. Below this article you will find their bio's and a note from T.C. Culpepper, current board member, who is up for re-election.

Gina Conklin of Houston Community Management Company answers a few questions regarding the upcoming annual board meeting that were asked by a resident. "There will be a mass mail out to the neighborhood about 2 weeks prior to the annual meeting which will **state the purpose of the meeting** etc.. The purpose of the Annual Meeting is to elect Board Members to the Board and to discuss the year end financials for December 2010 and a general open forum with the Homeowners." The **regular board meetings** during the year "are open to the public. The Homeowner can attend the regular business session, but once we enter into the Executive Session, they must leave as the Executive Session is for Board Members only where we talk about individual Homeowners accounts regarding Deed Restriction issues and Delinquent Assessments. The Board Meetings are held every other month, typically on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 5:30 PM, locations varies, it's best for the Homeowner to contact me to inquire when the next meeting is and the location. Although we have the meetings set for the 4th Tuesday of the month that we are meeting, sometimes things come up and we might have to reschedule the meeting due to lack of quorum. So it's best for a Homeowner to contact me to find out the date/time/place."

What does the Board actually do around here, in practical terms? "The Board places the budget for the year, oversees the management company in enforcing Deed Restrictions, and Assessment Collections, oversees the contracts such as landscape, management company, pool, oversees maintenance of the common grounds, pool, tennis court, park, etc."

What will the positions up for re/election be responsible for? "There are not certain positions that are up for re-election. The Homeowners are not voting in a President, Secretary or a Treasurer. They are voting a Homeowner onto the Board of Directors, and after they are elected, the Board amongst themselves come to a conclusion as to who will hold the President Office, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and Director at Large. No one really has authority over the other, they all have to vote as a whole to approve any contracts, file any lawsuits, etc. The President runs the meetings and makes sure that the meetings do not go off the agenda and that we stick with the agenda, they sign any new contracts, the Vice President will take the President roll if for some reason the President is absent from a meeting. The Treasurer reviews the financials and works with the management company financials rep if needed, the Secretary reviews the Board Meeting minutes for accuracy and signs them when they are approved. The Director at Large is another seat on the Board."

- 1) Click on "Associa Access" link on the left hand side of the screen.
- 2) Click on "Register" Link.
- 3) Enter your assessment account number, last name, street number and email address
- 4) Click on "Get Initial Login Info" button at the bottom of the page.

Once you have registered, you will receive an email, which will contain a link to Associa Access to create your own private login name and password. Please make a note of your login name and password and keep this information safe. After you have created your unique login name and password you can login to Associa Access to see your assessment account detail at anytime, day or night, from anywhere in the world.
